Since 1968, theses prepared in Humanities, Social and human sciences, Theology, Law, Political sciences, Economics and Management sciences are recorded in the Theses central file (FCT).

This database, open to the public, allows future doctoral students, thesis supervisors, and more generally the entire scientific community, to have an overview as complete as possible of the state of the ongoing doctoral research, and to review the situation of a specific research theme or of a field of study.

The notification of a thesis in preparation is one of the good practices giving visibility to the French research. **However, it does not guarantee any kind of protection or exclusivity on the chosen subject.**

The scientific interest or the originality of a subject depends on the dialogue between the Ph. D. student and the thesis supervisor whose role is to make sure the same subject has not been or is not being explored already.

In September 2011, the Theses central file managed by the ABES became STEP and expended onto every academic fields of research.

ABES is a technical operator in the notification of ongoing theses. Consequently it is neither its purpose nor its mission to issue a statement on the scientific interest of any submitted subject.
